
Carpenter Union Local 279 Scholarships



All Inclusive Carpenter Unions Scholarship Criteria

General Information

This is an All-Inclusive Application that <u>must be completed by the applicant</u> when applying for any of the Carpenter Unions twelve (12) scholarships.

Please note that each scholarship has varying criteria and eligibility. BE SURE YOUR QUALIFICATIONS ARE APPROPRIATE FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP YOU ARE APPLYING FOR.

You may apply for more than one scholarship as long as you meet the scholarship's criteria.

To apply for any of these scholarships, complete the All-Inclusive Application portion of this brochure (page 3). PLEASE PRINT ALL INFORMATION.

If you are currently attending college, a transcript of your college academic work must either accompany your application or be sent separately to the Dutchess Community College Foundation office.

If you are applying as an entering freshman, a transcript of your high school academic work must either accompany your application or be sent separately to the Dutchess Community College Foundation office.

These scholarships are funded by the following: Carpenters Local 279, Carpenters Local 203, and Alfred J. Papo Memorial Fund through the Dutchess Community College Foundation.

Applicant will be verified by the Carpenters Local 279 officials.

All selections are final and will be made by a committee, consisting of both Dutchess Community College Faculty and Administrators, which will be appointed by the Director of the Dutchess Community College Foundation.

Scholarship Criteria

The scholarship award may only be used for payment of tuition, books, fees or other college related expenses.

The scholarship award is payable to the selected college in September of the year based on the scholarship awarded. (Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior year).

The recipient must be a registered full-time student (12 credit hours or more) at their selected college.

Applicant must be a member or former member of Carpenters Local Union 279 and its prior Constituent Local Unions, a dependent or descendant of a member or former member.
